A few months ago, a senior Pratt staff member was walking through a Pratt branch library when she saw a father come in with his young daughter and her friend. The two girls joyfully ran into the children's section to select their books. At the same time, the father slowly walked over to the circulation desk to ask about the balance of his account.

As he looked in his wallet, he realized he wouldn't have enough money to cover his overdue fines. He slowly walked back to the girls to tell them they wouldn't be able to take books home that day. It's a scenario we've seen play out before, and one I hope we don't have to see again.

This summer, the Pratt Library becomes the first fine-free library in Maryland. We know fines can be a barrier to access for many of our customers. We want to relieve the financial pressure people may feel. However, the absence of fines does not mean a lack of responsibility. Customers who don't return materials will be charged replacement fees for lost or damaged items. All fees will be waived once those items are returned.

Going fine-free provides a fresh start for our community. So, to the senior citizen who missed the bus and couldn't get their books back in time, welcome back to the library. To the family that has to decide whether to put food on the table or pay their fines, we can't wait to see you. To the teen who forgot that DVD was under their bed, come back and see us. And to the little girl whose dad couldn't afford fines that day, I hope the library becomes a place you feel at home, a place that inspires a lifelong love of learning, just like it did for me.

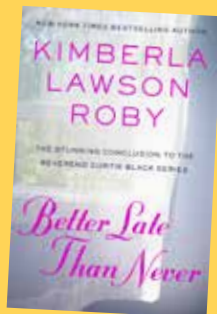

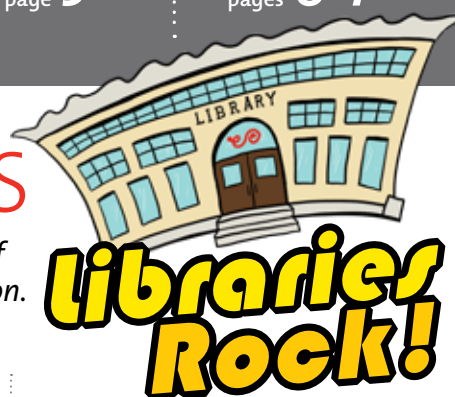
Curtis Black is no stranger to scandal. Throughout the decades, he has done much in the public eye, both good
