The Pratt Promotes Digital Literacy with New Wash & Learn Program



This summer the Pratt and community partners transformed laundromats into pop-up libraries!

CREATIVE PARTNERSHIP IS PUTTING A
NEW SPIN ON DOING YOUR LAUNDRY.
According to research, the average
American spends 90 minutes a
week in a laundromat with only half
of that time spent doing laundry.
Combine this with a tangible need for digital access
and training in Baltimore City, and you've got Wash
& Learn (WALI), an innovative initiative that is
placing the library's much-needed resources in four
local laundromats.

"The more the Library can be a presence in the community, the better" says Pratt President and CEO Heidi Daniel. "WALI is about removing

is about removing barriers and making sure all Baltimoreans can take advantage of the myriad of services that the Pratt offers as a 21st-century



library. It's exciting to offer our programs in spaces that act as community anchors in the same way our branches do."

In partnership with The Robert W. Deutsch Foundation, Media Democracy Fund, and Libraries Without Borders, the Pratt has equipped four landromats with technology installations, providing laptops and iPads for use whenever the laundromat is open. Customers can take a seat and follow basic technology tutorials, search for jobs, or connect with community resources, while children can develop early literacy skills, emotional intelligence, and basic coding skills on iPads. These tech stations look to promote digital equity, offering access and opportunities to connect.

Two of these laundromats will also feature the best resource the Pratt has to offer: librarians! WALI librarians are specially selected and specifically trained with expertise in early childhood literacy, technology, and Spanish. Teen outreach will be available four days a week. The Library's Mobile Job

Center will visit laundromat sites twice a month, providing important workforce development programming. As always, the Library's programs and services are free of charge.

This program represents an exciting new chapter for the Pratt with a clear nod to its core mission. "At the end of the day, it's about access and opportunity," says Daniel. "We want to make the passive time people spend in laundromats more active and engaging. You can work with a librarian to make your first resume or take your child to a storytime that sparks their love of learning. You might be able to take that first step towards a better life while meeting a very basic need."

WALI launched in June at HIPP Laundromat on Pulaski Highway, Laundry City on Frederick Ave, and two Sudsville Laundromats on Erdman Ave and Reisterstown Road.

Nancy Hackerman

N A SPRING DAY IN 1938, a young engineering student from Baltimore Polytechnic Institute was leaving the Forest Park branch with a friend when he literally collided with a young woman coming in through the front door. Willard Hackerman, then barely 19, asked 18-year-old Lillian Patz out for a date that same night and they were married three years later. Willard would soon join Whiting-Turner, and with the steady growth of the company, the Hackerman name became synonymous with civic and philanthropic leadership. Their support included a generous gift to maintain the branch where they first met.

Lillian and Willard's daughter Nancy, like her parents, was an early library fan. "I wanted to get my library card at the Pimlico branch," Nancy recalls, "but I was too young to sign my name." Her father came to the rescue. "He scratched my name on the card so I could copy over it," she says. Over the years, Nancy would carry on the family tradition of supporting the Pratt, particularly as the institution placed a growing focus on addressing the challenges facing city residents. Fifteen years ago, she joined the board where she remains today.

"So many of the branches are located in underserved neighborhoods that are facing tough issues like food deserts and joblessness," she explains. "There are a million opportunities for our libraries to improve these conditions by giving people the information and tools and support they need to transform their lives and get back on their feet." Pratt programs that help job seekers improve their chances of finding employment are of particular interest to her. In former Pratt board member Calvin Butler, the CEO of BGE, Nancy found a true partner.



"We both realized that if you don't create job opportunities for people, including young people, we will never address the difficult issues facing our city," says Butler. "When we do open up those opportunities, we create a sense of hope in the future among our residents that otherwise would not exist." Nancy saw BGE's Mobile Job Center as a positive model and worked with Baltimore City to extend the initiative. "Once Nancy gets her mind wrapped around an idea that she's passionate about, there's not a lot of talk, it's all action," explains Butler. "She wants to make a difference in the city, and she knows how to leverage whatever resources she has to make that happen."

Nancy is thrilled about the other community-based initiatives the Pratt's President and CEO Heidi Daniel is creating. "She is bringing the Library even more into the 21st century," Nancy says. Butler agrees. "The library continues to be a place for collaboration that offers much needed resources to the community," he says. "That's the roadmap Heidi is putting together."

On September 14, Nancy's tireless work as a Board member and co-chair of the highly successful Pratt Campaign for Central Library Renovations will be on full display as city residents celebrate the grand re-opening of the newly refurbished Central Library. "I'm very proud of this city, but we all must be," Nancy says. "We need everyone's ideas for how to make us better."


country. It's a much needed reminder that attention must be paid to all of those around us.


Daisy Jones & The Six by Taylor Jenkins Reid




The Care and Feeding of Ravenously Hungry Girls by Taylor Anissa Gray

Baltimore's peace organizers and the Pratt join forces.

HERE ARE MANY REASONS FOR ERRICKA BRIDGEFORD, a courageous grassroots organizer committed to ending gun violence in Baltimore, to feel discouraged. Last year, 309 people were killed in the city, and through July of this year, 151 citizens were gunned down. While those headlines break her heart, Erricka's message remains "obstinately" one of hope and resilience. "I have a deep belief that change will come to Baltimore," she says.

For nearly 20 years, Erricka worked in communities across the city as a trained mediator. But one day, in the spring of 2017, her 19-year-old son Paul turned to her and asked: "Mom, did you know that the murder rate in Baltimore is higher than ever before?" After a restless night, Erricka came up with a plan: "What if we designated just three days when nobody in Baltimore is going to kill anyone, and we're going to


Now in its third year, "Baltimore Ceasefire 365" continues to inspire anti-gun violence activities across the city. The success of its mission relies on the principle that no one person or organization can end the epidemic of violence by themselves.

"The whole city has to own it and do it together," says Erricka. In response, the Pratt Library has become a significant partner in these peace-focused efforts. Last year, in partnership with the T. Rowe Price Foundation and Baltimore City Public Schools, the Library launched the "One Book Baltimore" initiative that provides 7th and 8th graders and their families the chance to connect with each other by reading the same book.

Dear Martin, written by Nic Stone, is the story of a young Black kid who writes letters to Dr. Martin Luther King. "This was such a great choice," says Erricka, "because it speaks to so many

young people today who share that feeling of wanting to fit in, who struggle with ongoing violence, who believe grownups don't understand them." She and her "peace goon" activists collaborated with the Pratt to help lead conversations in all 22 library branches.

The Pratt also helped support another citywide campaign, "Choose Civility," and asked Erricka and her trained volunteers to host and help facilitate those community conversations in local Pratt libraries. "It's not easy to build a



On a broader scale, the Pratt Library supports the Ceasefire movement by spreading the word about its activities and promoting its message of non-violence. It offers spaces in its local branches to hold their meetings and activities, says Erricka, and dramatically expands the visibility of the movement by putting up their flyers and posters and calendars of events. Plus, she says, "Pratt Libraries are safe, and open, and free, and accessible, and its employees care deeply about what must be done to improve our City."

Erricka remembers the 2015 Freddie Gray uprising when the Pratt Library in Penn North opened its doors when so many others were slamming theirs shut. "That kind of positive response reflects the high level of trust that the Pratt has earned in our communities over the years."

And the Pratt will again organize the "One Book" initiative, with the selected book to be announced when the author joins Baltimore's 7th and 8th graders at the Central Library for a free event on October 1, 2019. Once again, Ceasefire mediators will gather in Pratt branches citywide to help spark and lead those critically important discussions. And thanks to a recently donated car, Erricka can more easily attend the growing number of meetings and trainings that now fill her days.
