<b>Abstract</b>	The Cynthia Gault Smith Letters consists of letters and ephemera between Smith and World War II servicemen between 1944 and 1949. Several letters suggest affection with Smith, her future husband, John "Smitty" Smith.

## Scope and Contents note

---

The Cynthia Gault Smith Letters comprise her correspondence with seven servicemen during the World War II. The letters are organized alphabetically by the servicemen's last name and are filed chronologically. Several of the men seemed to have been in love with her, and is reflected in the Sherman E. Murray "Daddy" letters, which comprise the bulk of the collection. The collection also consists of letters from her future husband, John "Smitty" Smith as well as a letter and card from her to him along with a lock of her hair.
